CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

After analyzing and discussing the findings in the previous chapter, the writer would like to draw some conclusions and offer several suggestions in this current chapter.

5.1 Conclusion

After analyzing the data, the writer can conclude that:

5.1.1 The level of English retelling short story of the second year students of SwastaKatolik Warta BaktiKefamenanu is categorized excellent. The students' average score is of 3.75.

5.1.2 The second year students of SMA SwastaKatolik Warta BaktiKefamenanu. The most difficult aspect of speaking is pronunciation, grammar, vocabulary and fluency. It is indicated by the data that level of ability is good with their score of grammar aspect 3,11. It is followed by vocabulary that level of ability is good with their score 3.22, and their score on pronunciation aspect was 3,66 so that the level of ability is excellent, on the fluency aspect their score was 3,33 with their level of ability is good.

5.2 Suggestion

5.2.1 For English Teachers

- The English teachers have to give more motivation for all students in learning English especially in speaking using conversation.
- The English teachers should give more attention in guiding the student in conversation especially in the aspects of speaking (grammar, vocabulary, fluency, and pronunciation).

5.2.2 For the Students

- The students should practice more in speaking English using conversation and focus on all aspects of speaking.
- The students have to implement the aspects of speaking used conversation when practice it every time.
