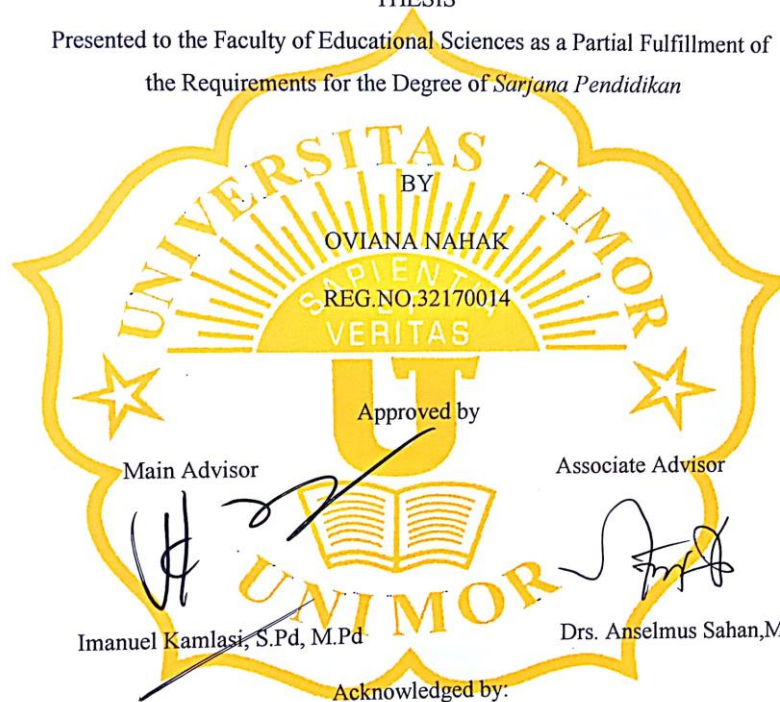

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

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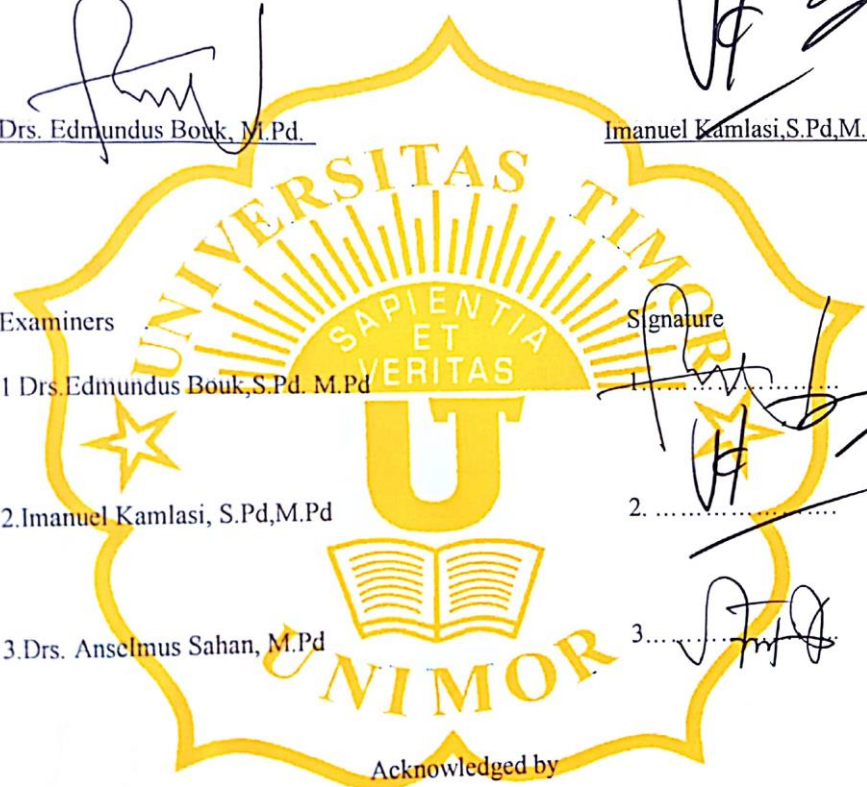

It means that Misformation is still the difficult part for them to master writing the abstract.
