Especially if we read a book or written in English, for that be an active reader, crisis and creative. Snow (2002:11) states reading comprehension is a process of extracting and constructing a meaning simultaneously through interaction and through involvement with the written language. Reading Comprehension is an active process. Active reading involves an interaction with information or to create an internal dialogue with the material. Andreson (1994) believes that effective reading is an important factor for success in learning other languages. He explained that, language learning had become a big problem for some students. If someone does not have enough reading comprehension, then there is no communication with their environment or to face global competition. Therefore, reading comprehension is a major element in language proficiency which is the basis of how good learners can focus on reading and listening inputs, and then outputs that focus on the meaning of speaking and writing.

In reading English text or writing, students' reading comprehension is still very low. Reading is not just a process of remembering, but a work process that requires aspects of crisis and creative thinking to be able to understand the purpose or content of the reading.
