5.1 Conclusion

After analyzing the data, the researcher concluded students' speaking problems and some solutions they uses to faced the problems. The problem faced by student in Speaking English.

Based on the results of research from comprehension, it was found the students had problems in speaking related to speaking aspects including grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, and fluency.
