CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Study

1.6.1 Improving

Improving is about adding the ability on doing something. Improving makes better progress in learning process. Improving shows the changing of people skill to be better in material which is given. As it is mentioned in Oxford Dictionary (2011) that improving is the process of becoming or making to be better, so the teacher's task is increasing the student's ability and activeness in class.

1.6.2 Reading Comprehension

According to Klingner (2007:2), reading comprehension is "the process of constructing meaning by coordinating a number of complex processes that included word reading, word and world knowledge, and fluency". It refers to the ability in interpreting the words, understanding the meaning and the relationships between ideas conveyed in a text.

1.6.3 RAP Strategy

The RAP strategy is based on a theory that identifies paraphrasing as a key skill to help improve students' memory of main ideas and details in text. According to JanetteK. Klingner (2007), developed and evaluated the effectiveness of the paraphrasing strategy for use

with expository or informational texts. First students read the paragraph and think about what it means while reading. Then they ask them selves to identify the main idea of the paragraph. Finally they put the main idea and supporting details into their own words.
